I worked with a group of international artists in an open-ended brief to facilitate the creation of "something" with, by, and for the rural village community of Ejsing, using the methodology of Cultural Barter. This something ended up turning into a week-long artistic festival that included an art exhibition, banquets, and series of concerts in the local church, as well as a musical storytelling performance involving horses at a local farm. Many of these ideas were instigated and led by the villagers themselves with input and guidance from us as the artists.

October 2023 - February 2025

Whilst I was an ESC volunteer with Theatre Brama I was responsible for planning & leading workshops with the youth & children's theatre groups and helping with the day-to-day running of the theatre. I also took on additional responsibilities within the theatre such as co-leading morning training and assistant directing and stage managing the spring performance *Solider of the Queen of Madagascar*. I was also invited to tour with the company, running rehearsals and workshops with local communities in Sandefjord in Norway, Ustrzyki Dolne in Poland, & Frankfurt in Germany to create a series of Rock Operas. I have since returned to facilitate the creation of two parades for BRAMAT festivals in 2023 and 2024, and to direct "Perfectly Imperfect" a non-verbal clown show for ages 3+ in 2025.

# Stella Polaris, Sandefjord, Norway

August 2021 - September 2024

As part of my Erasmus+ Traineeship with *Stella Polaris* in Norway, I co-ran groups 1+2 of their children's theatre (ages 6-13), and plan and run entertaining and educational drama and circus skill workshops for children from the local community. After my placement I returned to work with Stella Polaris as an Actor and Pedagogue, working on international European projects co-creating large scale outdoor performances with communities, performing and running workshops with an international ensemble.
